

## FROM THE COMMITTEE MEETING 10 NOVEMBER 2021

**LESSONS (beginner, supported play, intermediate):** We are attempting to organise **beginner** lessons to start in the new year. If you know anyone interested in learning our great game, please let Bev Lawler know so she can follow up.

**Supported** play will recommence Monday 6 December 2021 (10.00am) with lots of encouragement to join in regular play.

**Intermediate** lessons to be conducted by Ian Spight are now scheduled to begin Wednesday 12 January 2022 for nine weeks. Please refer to the brochures on display and email regarding this to see what is being offered.

**PROGRAM for 2022:** Our program for next year is being prepared. If you have had any change to your contact details, please advise Sandra Robinson immediately so these are included in the new program.

**FEE INCREASE:** The ABF fee has been increased. To cover this cost, it is proposed to increase our annual fees to \$30. It is also proposed to increase our table fees by \$1 to \$5 for members and \$7 for visitors. Whilst table fees can be increased by the Committee, it was agreed that both these proposals will go to a Special General Meeting to be held 12 noon Monday 6 December 2021.

**COVID REVIEW:** The only change to our current COVID regulations is the replacement of the 4-square metre rule with the 2-square rule. This means we can increase the number of players from 60 to 120, and the number of people in the kitchen at any one time from 7 to 14. All other rules (including masks, unfortunately) still apply.
