

Tournament Committee definition

1. The Tournament Committee shall be a permanent sub-committee of the Club appointed annually by and responsible to the Management Committee.
2. The Tournament Committee shall consist of *four* members including:

Club Masterpoint Secretary

include at least two directors.

3. The Tournament Committee shall elect a Minutes Secretary.
4. The Tournament Committee shall be responsible for the:
 - a) Conduct of bridge sessions at the Club in accordance with The Laws of duplicate Bridge promulgated by the World Bridge Federation and BAWA and ABF Regulations as appropriate. The Tournament Committee will endeavour to resolve infringements. If this fails both the Management Committee and the Tournament Committee should meet.
 - b) Preparation of the calendar of all Club events for the forthcoming calendar year by fixing the dates for the regular club events, deciding when to allocate our red points and determining which State and National competitions the Club will enter in the coming year. Provide the calendar to the Committee for review and the production of the annual diary.
 - c) Operation and maintenance of bridge equipment to ensure that the Club always has the necessary equipment to run its regular sessions and the annual congress.
 - d) Determine what movements are to be played at Club events, in conjunction with the Chief Director
 - e) Do the administration for State and National competitions.
 - f) Handle appeals against Directors' decisions
 - g) Organisation of inter club pairs or teams events.
 - h) Formulation of Supplementary Regulations as necessary to supplement the laws and regulations specified in Clause 4a
